Detective Camp August 3rd- 7th Playing detective helps kids learn how to organize facts and analyze information. This week we will be decoding secret messages, playing I spy, exploring finger prints and going on flashlight hunts. For the tasty treat this week we will be making decoder cookies the kids can use to decode message and then enjoy.

Dinosaur Camp August 10th- 14th Paleontology is a great opportunity to teach kids about biology and scientific thinking.
